- E4 Carolinas has been contract by the Nuclear Energy Institute to assist in inventorying and surveying Carolina companies and organizations with a nuclear interest. 153 to companies and organizations have been identified. 83 have had phone interviews regarding the survey with 54 completing the survey. 70 will still be contacted and surveyed.
- E4 Carolinas is collaborating with ClearPath Foundation to better connect it with the Carolina's nuclear community. ClearPath Foundation's objective is to convince Republican policy-makers of clean energy's value and believes nuclear energy to be a key component of our future clean power portfolio.
- In early 2017 we will begin inviting Carolina nuclear energy professionals to join the Carolinas Nuclear Cluster Network; a member-only website containing content from LEC seminars, member contact information, nuclear event information, etc. E4 Carolinas members may join the Network at no cost. Non-members may join for a small fee.
